CLASSES and RUNNING ORDER: THIS IS A DOUBLE RUN TRIAL

Standard, Junior Handler and Veteran / Disabled Handler and FEO; Intro is offered in all Classes.
This running order is subject to change at the Judge's and /or Club's discretion.

Friday: 2 Touch and Go, 2 Tunnelers
Saturday: 2 Weavers, 2 Numbered Hoopers, 2 Chances, 2 Regular
Sunday: 2 Regular, 2 Jumpers, 2 X-Hoopers

INTRO ENTRIES: The dog may jump at a lower jump height than its Standard height. Please indicate the Intro jump height on the entry form.

FEO ENTRIES (For Exhibition Only): The dog must jump one jump height lower than its Standard height, must be registered with NADAC, and must be 18 months or older. The run will be judged for safety only and is not eligible for points or for qualifying credit.

MOVE UPS: Accepted day to day but not during the day.

ENTRIES: LIMITED TO 500 RUNS PER DAY - 350 RUNS IN CLASSES WITH JUMPS
Entries Are Now Open and close on the Wednesday night before the trial or when the trial fills.

Sunday: First Walk-thru 8:15 am, first dog on the line at 8:30 am
Friday: Small to Tall / Saturday: Tall to Small / Sunday: Small to Tall

PRE-ENTRY FEES: Entries close on the WED night before the trial.

Fees are based on total number of runs for all dogs entered by the same household:

1-11 runs	\$10.00 per run	/	JH \$5.00 per run
12-17 runs	\$ 9.00 per run	/	JH \$4.00 per run
18+ runs	\$ 8.00 per run	/	JH \$3.00 per run .

DAY OF SHOW FEES: \$11.00 (JH \$5.00) per run if the handler has not pre-entered any dogs. However when adding Day Of to a pre-entry then the **pre-entry rates will apply.** **Day Of Show runs must be entered BEFORE the course is set.** FEO runs are available at the same pricing as above.

AWARDS:

PLACEMENT: 1ST – 4TH in each class except Chances which is pass/fail only.

QUALIFYING: Purple Qualifying Ribbons

SPECIALITY RIBBONS: TITLES (2/day/person), NATCH and V-NATCH Ribbons

HIGH IN TRIAL ROSETTES: (based on the first Regular Level entered)

Each team is eligible for ONE of the following HIT Rosettes:

- * Intro, Novice, Open, Elite, Non-herding, or Mixed Breed
- * High in Trial is determined by the number of Qs. HIT points are weighted by Level:
Intro 3 points, Novice 5, Open 10, Elite 15. EGC will be 5, 10 or 15 points for all levels.
- * X-hoopers will not be included in HIT calculations EXCEPT ties will be broken by the first x-hoopers class and/or speed points as calculated by AU program.

DIRECTIONS:

REFUND POLICY:

If the Dept. of Transportation closes any interstate or secondary roads, all but \$4 entry for each run will be refunded. If someone withdraws from this trial before closing date, full refund will be given. In case of an injured dog or a bitch in heat, all but \$4 for each run will be refunded after the closing date.

NADAC INFORMATION - PLEASE READ

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.

Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.

The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

NON-JUMPING CLASSES – VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the Non-Jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled Handlers in the Non-Jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

IMPORTANT: Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

TRIAL RESULTS: NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

LEVELS: Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

FOOD/TOYS IN POCKET: Food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a zip lock bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container cannot be visible in the ring nor within 10 feet of the ring. You may not indicate to your dog that you have this item on you i.e. by patting your pocket. You are not allowed to remove the container until you are at least 10 feet outside the ring. All food and toys must be contained at the trial and none can be left lying about loose. This policy has been implemented to reduce the possibility of dogs fighting over loose food or toys, diminish dogs dragging their handlers back to their crates (or wherever they left their food), and to lessen the amount of insects that are around loose food.

As of January-2014: Dogs must enter the Veterans Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes.

The show committee has the right to refuse entry to anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC.

NO AGGRESSIVE DOGS OR PEOPLE ARE ALLOWED. This trial is to have fun with your dogs and enjoy the sport of agility.

PLEASE KEEP YOUR DOG ON A LEASH WHEN NOT IN THE RING. DOGS MAY NOT BE TIED TO A CRATE OR TREE OR ANYTHING ELSE.

PLEASE Clean up after your dogs.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state or province in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (Including NADAC officers directors, employees and members), YELLOWSTONE DOG SPORTS (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I/we certify that I/we have knowledge of, and are familiar with, and agree to abide by, the rules and Regulations of NADAC in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations as approved by NADAC for this trial.
