## **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from any or all ASCA programs, or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
  - Pre-entries will be refunded only upon written request received prior to close of pre-entries. No other refunds will be granted.
  - All entries must be submitted on the latest approved ASCA entry form, for the event in which your dog is entered. Entry forms are available on the ASCA website, at [www.asca.org/home/business-office/rules-forms](http://www.asca.org/home/business-office/rules-forms).
    - All non-ASCA dogs must have a Tracking Number in order to compete in rally trials.
  - Any check returned to our bank will invalidate all entries associated with that check. Writer of the check will be required to pay a \$50 administrative fee, in addition to all bank charges associated with the returned check. If the issue is not resolved within 10 days, the writer of said check will be reported to ASCA.
  - No class changes will be made after close of entries.
  - No bitches in season will be allowed to participate in any class in this trial.
  - Dogs must be a minimum of 6 months of age to compete in any class in this trial. The age of all dogs will be calculated as of July 5, 2025.
  - No classes will be judged prior to the posted start times on the schedule but may be judged later.
  - **Venue:** Rally and obedience trials will be performed within the new YDS indoor facility,—The new building is a 60x80 indoor facility with heavy rubber floor mats with a designated crating area. Food and beverages are only allowed in the crating area. Building will be open to exhibitors at 7:30 am.
  - **Local Emergency Veterinarian:**
    - Moore Lane Veterinary Hospital, 406-252-4159, 30 Moore Lane, Billings Moore Lane Hospital is staffed 24 hours with a veterinarian on call.
    - Grizzly Peak Animal Hospital, 406-446-1778, 7165 US Hwy 212, Red Lodge
    - Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

    - **Use Google Maps for best directions from your location--7753 Hwy. 212, Roberts, MT 59070. 8 miles north of Red Lodge, MT and 37 miles south of Laurel, MT, between mile markers 77 and 78.**
