SECTION 2: ENTERING THE TRIAL

Wherever the word "dog" is used in this premium, it includes both sexes. This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP prefix), an AKC Canine Partners listing (MA prefix) or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs entered should be physically sound. Not eligible are dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form.

Entry Fees and Information for Entering

First entry of each dog (includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee)..... \$20.00
Second entry of same dog, same trial (includes a \$3.00 AKC recording fee)..... \$19.00
Third entry of same dog, same trial (includes a \$3.00 AKC recording fee) \$19.00
Each additional entry of same dog, same trial (includes a \$3.00 AKC recording fee) . \$19.00

Mail entry forms and fees to: **Kristi Hayes, 1116 Lendel Ln, Billings MT 59102**. Make checks or money orders (no cash will be accepted) payable to **Labor Day Agility Cluster (or LDAC)**. Phone or fax entries will not be accepted. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Online Entries may be made via R2 Agility Online: www.R2AgilityOnline.com.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries 100; Paper entries 250. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either

the online or paper limits accordingly. No hand deliveries will be accepted in the first twenty-four hours following the opening date and time.

Refunds

100% of entry fees will be refunded for any reason if written (or email) request is received by the TRIAL SECRETARY on or before the closing day and time. IF YOU ENTERED ONLINE: Before the closing date and time, cancel your entry by using the online system.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

The club will refund all entry fees, less \$6.00/day, for **bitches in season** when notification is received by the TRIAL SECRETARY at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trials. **FEO** will be offered for all classes.

Classes Offered, Judging Start Time, Class Order

Exhibitors should consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description of, and eligibility for entry into, classes, and for complete information about jump heights. It is the exhibitor's express responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class and jump height. After the closing date/time, the Trial Secretary cannot make corrections to entries if the error is a mistake on entry received. HINT: **Carefully review your confirmation!**

Move-ups Before the Trial

Move-ups as a result of titles earned after entries close must be submitted in writing or email so that the Trial Secretary receives them by **6:00 PM MDT on Monday, August 25**. Include the dog's call name, owner's name, class dog is moving from, and class dog is moving to (HINT: replying to your final CONFIRMATION EMAIL is an ideal way to complete a move-up). If you do not receive acknowledgement of your move-up request within 24 hours of sending, please contact the TRIAL SECRETARY to make sure that it was received. No phone move ups accepted.

Jump Height Divisions

Please check the box on the entry form so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*.

All dogs competing must have a valid AKC Jump Height Card OR must be measured by the judge of record prior to running. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the dog measured. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" jump height division. If a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Representative is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card (including those entered in the 24" jump height division) must be measured during the trial or cluster of trials.

SECTION 3: TRIAL DAY

Building Hours and Crating

Indoor crating space is available on rubber mats over dirt and in a concrete-floored annex. Please take only the space you need. Ex-pens may be used only if they house multiple dogs. On Friday, the building will be open for exhibitors at 6:30 AM. It is possible the building will be open Thursday night for set-up; information will be included on the Trial Information document sent after closing.

Course maps, walk-throughs and warm-up jump

Exhibitor copies of course maps will be posted.

Judge's briefing and course walk-throughs will occur prior to each class. Each walkthrough is restricted to handlers entered in that class and the jump heights specified. Handlers with multiple dogs may request to walk with an alternate height group if a conflict is expected.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. Dogs are judged in the order posted on the ringside running order. Changes in that order may be approved by the gate steward (when delegated authority by the judge) prior to the start of the class. Handlers are required to see the gate steward if requesting a change as allowed in the AKC trial regulations. Please don't change the order without express permission!

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Ribbons, Awards and Prizes

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH/PACH rosette and decorated MACH/PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH.

IMPORTANT: If you are close to earning a MACH or PACH award, please let the appropriate TRIAL CHAIRS know so that the clubs are prepared to celebrate with you.

Notice to Exhibitors

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

By submitting an entry form, exhibitors are asserting they are aware of all rules and regulations pertaining to this trial and as published by the clubs and the facility owner. All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/>.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor who themselves or whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. **This includes dogs harassing livestock on YDS property or adjacent properties.** The Yellowstone Valley Kennel Club, the Gallatin Dog Club, the Trial Secretary and the property Yellowstone Dog Sports and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The clubs reserve the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression or any exhibitor if considered necessary by the club or clubs. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Yellowstone Valley Kennel Club, the Gallatin Dog Club, the Trial Secretary or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

Move-ups During the Trial Weekend

Move-ups for Saturday and Sunday must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the last class on the previous day. For allowed changes from Novice A to Novice B, refer to Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
